

## Requirements

1. Attach a 250-500 word essay outlining your future goals and why you are applying for NARI's scholarship.
2. Attach a letter of recommendation from one of your current shop instructors.
3. Attach a letter of recommendation from your principal, another instructor, or employer.

Scholarships will be awarded in the form of tools if entering the workforce after graduation or cash if attending a vocational program, junior college, or four year college.

## Requirements

- Must be a graduating senior with a GPA of 2.6
- Students must submit an application and two letters of recommendation (at least one must be from the school they are attending.) In addition, the student must submit a 250-500 word essay describing why they should be considered for the scholarship.

## Classroom Grants

The Education Fund also offers grants to school programs that provide construction/carpentry programs to its students. Members of the Education Fund also support and participate in school-to-career activities.
